

PURPOSE

• The purpose of the East Idaho Credit Union scholarship program is to award one \$3,000 and six \$1000 scholarships to East Idaho Credit Union members to aid them in their pursuit of higher education. Scholarships are a single monetary reward to be applied to the cost of tuition, books, and/or lab fees (if applicable).

ELIGIBILITY

- Must be a member of East Idaho Credit Union with an account in your name.
- Must be a graduating high school senior and plan to attend an accredited college, university or technical school in the United States as a full-time student. (Funds can be held if student is planning a gap year or service opportunity before enrolling in college.)
- Must provide verification of acceptance to school before scholarship funds are disbursed.
- Must have a GPA of 3.0 or greater.

APPLICATION REQUIREMENTS

- All required portions of the application must be completed and returned by March 31, 2020.
- A supporting essay must accompany each scholarship application.
- A supporting letter of recommendation must accompany each scholarship application.
- A current transcript with GPA must accompany each scholarship application.

ESSAY REQUIREMENTS

- Essay must be no less than one page and no longer than two pages in length on the given topic.
- Essay must be typed using Times New Roman 12-point font, double-spaced, and have margins of 1" on the top and bottom and left and right.
- Applicant's full name must appear at the top of each page of the essay.
- Essay will be judged based on content, proper use of grammar, spelling and punctuation.

ESSAY TOPIC

- Who has been your biggest influence and why?

BASIS OF SELECTION

- Winners will be judged and selected based on the following criteria:

GPA	10%
Student Involvement/Work Experience	25%
Volunteer Work/Community Involvement	15%
Essay	25%
Letter of Recommendation	10%
Length of EICU Membership	10%
